The buccal swab specimen collection

- 1. Complete the Form about animal (information about animal name of animal, registration N_{o} , chip) for each individual. Perform the collection of buccal swab samples from only one individual at a time. For one animal, use both swabs (collection of buccal swabs contains two samples)
- 2. Wash and dry hands thoroughly.
- 3. Carefully peel apart the sleeve containing the sterile buccal swab. Remove buccal swab carefully, holding the swab by the stick.
- 4. Rotate gently the swab on the inside of the right cheek of the appropriate individual for approximately 15 seconds.
- 5. Repeat for remaining swab, this time collecting from the left cheek.
- 6. Dry the swabs outside without any contact at room temperature for at least 30 minutes.
- 7. After the swabs are completely dry, immediately place the swabs directly into the appropriate envelope from collection kit.
- 8. After completing the collections, double check to ensure that the information has been correctly filled in on the collection kit's surface (name of animal, registration $N_{\rm o}$, chip) together with the completed Form about animal
